There have been a lot of questions lately about power lines and Powell Butte.

Crook County has written a letter and stated in a public meeting that we are not in favor of any of the currently proposed routes.

Here is a statement directly from PacifiCorp. As you can see, they have not made a decision — but please, don't just take my word for it.

Below is a number you can call to contact PacifiCorp specifically about the Blueprint Project.

I urge you: if you have questions, contact the company directly and ask them. I always find it's best to get information straight from the horse's mouth.

“PacifiCorp has not made any decisions on route selection for Project Blueprint. The project team is continuing to evaluate public feedback.
